Benthic Macroinvertebrate Sampling Program

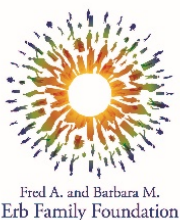
Learn about what lives in the river and help Friends of the Rouge at the same time. Volunteers meet at Schoolcraft, then venture out in teams to sample two sites under the direction of a trained Team Leader. Volunteers do not enter the water but work streamside to search samples for aquatic insects, clams and snails. Results are used to assess the health of the river.

No prior experience is necessary, just an interest in the river and the ability to be outside in varying weather conditions and maneuver at sites with uneven footing. Children five years and older are welcome when accompanied by one participating adult per child. Groups larger than six will be split.
