ARC – ECT 2022 IDEP Work Plan Presented to: ARC Technical Committee – 2/18/2021

Scope of Work

ECT will follow-up on the results from the 2021 investigations according to the Rouge River Collaborative IDEP Plan. This will include investigating suspicious discharges at Category A and B outfalls located in Beverly Hills, Inkster and Livonia.

The planned investigations are outlined in Table 1.

Community	Priority Outfalls	Next Steps
Beverly Hills	BV51	Work with Beverly Hills to have the tributary lines televised and determine next steps.
Inkster	Lower Rouge River Outfall 47A	Resample the outfall and work with Inkster to identify the source of dry weather flow.
Livonia	L1619 and U2008221	Resample the outfalls and upstream manholes to narrow down possible pollutant source locations. Work with Livonia to televise and dye test based on sample findings.

 Table 1. Planned Investigations Summary for 2022

ECT will contact the local community prior to the onset of field work and provide periodic updates as warranted. The community may be requested to aid with traffic control and conduct CCTV work, if deemed necessary.

The output of this work plan are individual community summary reports with tables and maps showing the results of the inspections and sampling. The reports will also include recommendations for next steps.
